**Pickup and Dropoff Information**

- The Parade is on **Sunday, December 8, 2019** in Wellington.
- Final Drop off and Pickup details will be communicated via email, Facebook and will be available on our website [www.kemkids.com](http://www.kemkids.com) a few days before the parade. We have to wait for the City of Wellington to give us this information. We will make it available to you as soon as we receive it.
- Drop-Off: The drop-off time is between **11 AM and 11:30 AM**. The car drop-off location last year was the parking lot on the Southeast corner of Forest Hill Blvd. and Wellington Trace in the Checkers parking lot. You may also park and walk your child to the assigned KemKids parade staging area. Please do not park in the car drop-off area. The location of the car drop-off and assigned staging area will be announced in the final parade information sent out a few days before the parade.
- Pick-Up: The parade begins at 1:30 PM. **Please pick up your children immediately following their performance at the judges table (see pickup location below), not after the entire parade is over. PLEASE WAIT FOR ALL CHILDREN TO BE ORGANIZED IN THEIR ASSIGNED GROUPS FOR DISMISSAL.** The Pickup location last year was west on South Shore Blvd from Forest Hill Blvd (corner where veteran's memorial is) behind the Shoppes at Chancellor (right side).
- **Again, this is only preliminary information, final drop-off and pick up information will be communicated via email, Facebook and will be available on our website [www.kemkids.com](http://www.kemkids.com) as soon as we receive it, which is typically a few days before the parade.**
- We will have 1 Adult Chaperone for every 10 children participating in the Parade.

### What should the children bring?

- Children should bring a snack and full lunch in **disposable** packaging. We will have water available but you should send them with a drink for snack and lunch.
- Please do not send any personal items with your children. We cannot guarantee the safety of personal items.

### Attire:

- Children must be dressed in their costume with hair and make-up done when they arrive.
- All girls are required to wear the same colored **tights (Suntan)** that were included with the parade costume.
- **Girls should wear White Tennis Shoes with white socks.** Suggestions on where to purchase: Target store and online at [www.target.com](http://www.target.com) . Please do not wait until the day before the parade to look for them, they can be hard to find in the correct size.

Please do not wait until the day before the parade to look for them, they can be hard to find in the correct size.
- Girls hair in Pig Tails, with provided bows clipped on top of each pig tail. If your dancer's hair is too short for pigtails leave hair down, and place bow clips above the ears on each side of their head.

- **Optional Make-up:** Black mascara, black eyeliner, pink blush, red lipstick, neutral eye shadow.
